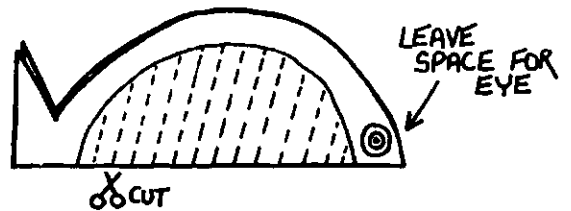
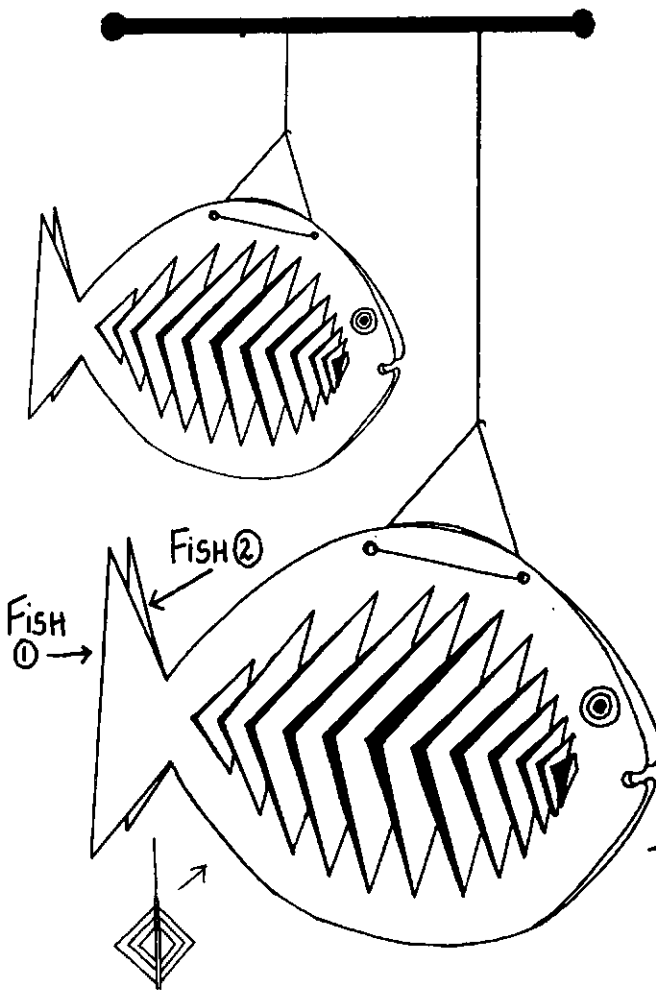


Relief Fish

- A CUT OUT TWO FISH SHAPES THE SAME SIZE BUT IN DIFFERENT COLOURS.
- B KEEPING THEM TOGETHER, FOLD THEM OVER IN TWO AND DRAW A SEMI-CIRCLE LIGHTLY IN PENCIL.

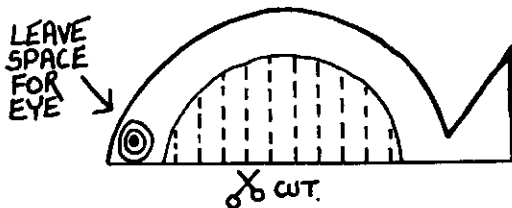


- C MAKE DIAGONAL CUTS, ABOUT 2CM. APART, AS ABOVE.
- D OPEN EACH FISH OUT FLAT. BEND OUT AND CREASE OVER EVERY CUT SO THAT THEY STICK OUT AT RIGHT ANGLES TO THE FISH'S BODY. STICK ON EYES. HANG FISH TOGETHER BACK TO BACK.



Woven Fish

- A CUT OUT FISH SHAPE (USE THE DARKER SHADES) AND FOLD OVER IN TWO.
- B DRAW SEMI-CIRCLE LIGHTLY IN PENCIL AND MAKE CUTS ABOUT 1½ cm. APART.



- C OPEN OUT FLAT. CUT STRIPS OF SUGAR PAPER (ABOUT 1½ cm. WIDE) IN TWO BRIGHT COLOURS. WEAVE THEM IN AND OUT OF THE CUTS. START IN THE CENTRE AND THEN WEAVE ONE EITHER SIDE EACH TIME. PASTE DOWN ENDS IF NECESSARY. PASTE AN EYE ON BOTH SIDES AND HANG.
