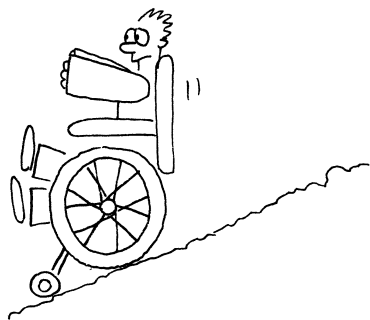


Acting the Maggot (expression)

Arseways (adj)

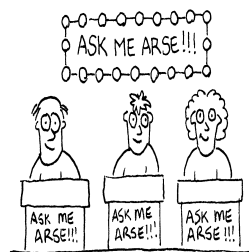
Mishmash. Complete disarray. Total mess.
