I want to be BIG.'

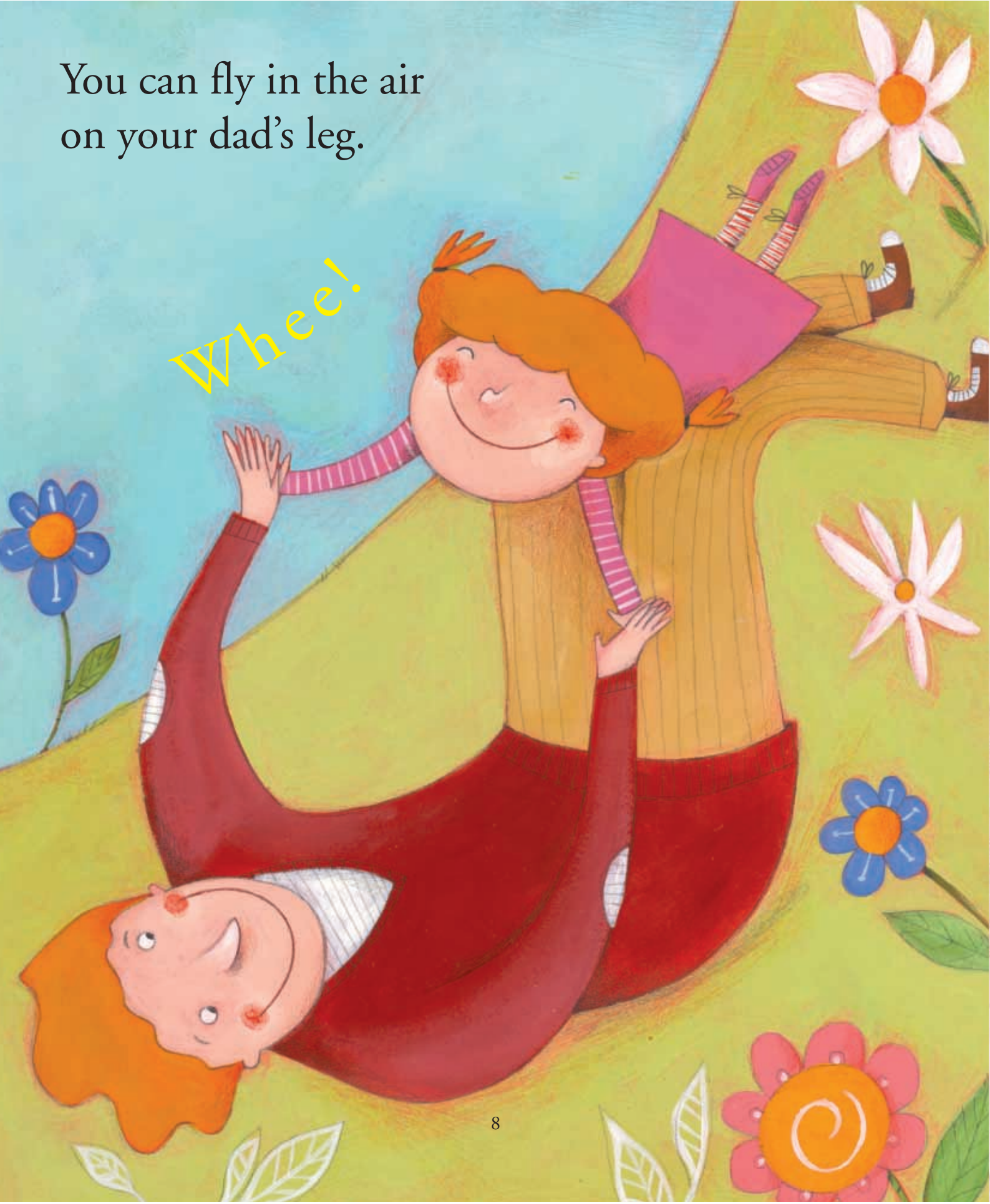


‘What!’ her granny replied.

Whee!

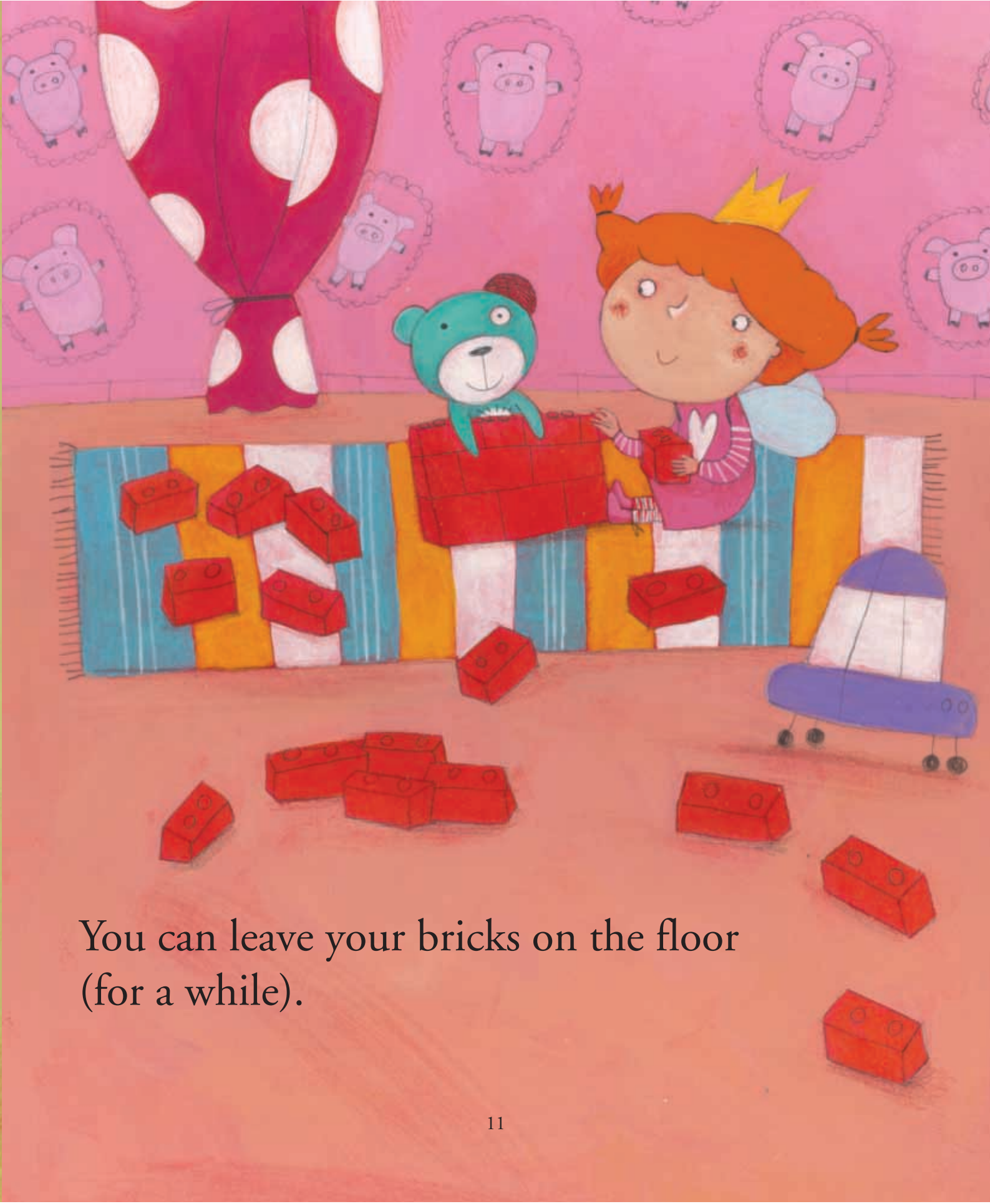


You can make up words
