

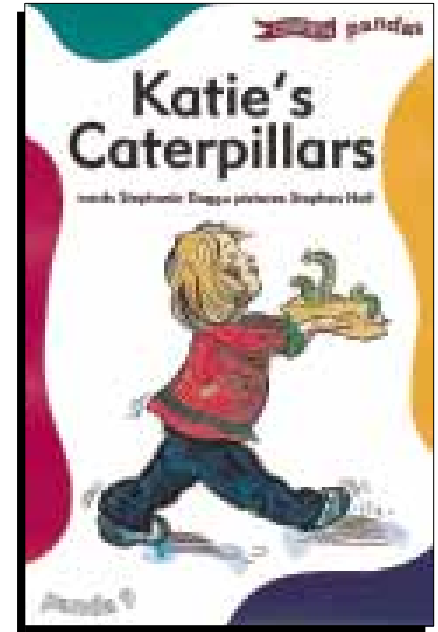
ACTIVITY SHEET 9

BEETLE DRIVE

When Katie lost interest in butterflies, she started to like beetles! Here's a beetle game to play.

You will need:

- one playing die
- a sheet of paper per player
- a pencil for each player



How to play:

Take it in turns to roll the die. Depending on the number that comes up, you draw a different part of your beetle. The first person to have a finished beetle with one body, one head, six legs, two wings, two eyes and two antennae is the winner.

Here are the numbers for the different parts of the body:

6 – body. You have to draw the body first, so you must roll a 6 before you can start to draw your beetle.

5 – head.

4 – leg. Remember, you need six legs so you must roll a 4 six times!

3 – wing. You need two wings.

2 – eye. You need two eyes.

1 – antenna. You need two antennae.
