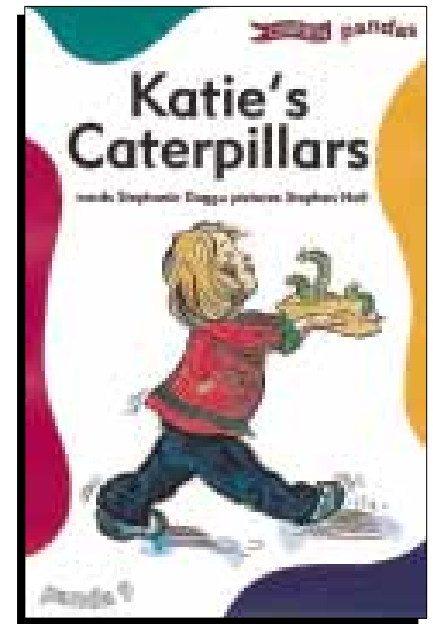


ACTIVITY SHEET 10
